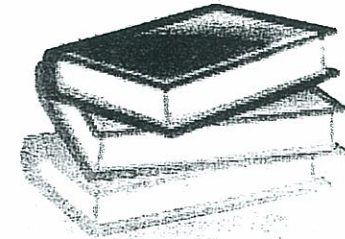
Junior High School Students
